Mission Trip Policies, Procedures, and Considerations

- The youth pastor and the mission committee will review your application and a personal interview may be required.
- Short-term mission trips can be rewarding and life changing: however, they can also be stressful. Please consider factors in your personal life at this time that may distract or prohibit you from fully committing to the mission of the trip and adapting to unusual conditions.
- Once accepted, team members are expected to attend ALL team meetings.
- All trip costs are the team member's responsibility and due one month before departure. Your leader will provide information that suggests ways to raise financial support. However, if full support is not raised, the balance is your responsibility.
- There may be scholarship money available for a portion of the cost. Scholarship applications are due by May 15.
- If you are unable to participate in your trip, the leader must receive cancellation notice as soon as possible. **Monies put towards mission trips are contributions, and the Internal Revenue Service prohibits the refund of contributions.**
